# Guide for Garbage Separation and Disposal

Take your garbage to the collection site by **8 a.m.** on the designated collection day. There will be no garbage collection on **Sundays, National holidays or the New Year holiday.**

Take your garbage according to disposal and separation rules.



Burnable garbage	Three times a week Day of the week Use the designated bags.	<b>Kitchen garbage</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kitchen scraps, leftovers, fruit peel, egg shells, disposable wooden chopsticks, clamshells, etc.</li> <li>Used cooking oil must be hardened or soaked up in newspapers.</li> </ul> <p>Designated bags: 燃やすごみ</p> <p>Drain any liquid before disposal.</p> <p>* A subsidy is available for the purchase of a kitchen compost container.</p>	<b>Tree branches (twigs, leaves and grass clippings)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fallen leaves and grass clippings (Use the designated bag.)</li> <li>Tree branches (Within 2 cm in thickness and 50 cm in length)</li> <li>Wooden boards (Cut boards and make them into a bundle of roughly 5 pieces, no more than 20 cm in width, 50 cm in length and 2 cm in thickness.)</li> </ul>	<b>Wastepaper, etc. (Non-recyclable papers)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tissues, vinyl-coated papers, foil-lined papers, photos, duck tapes, carbon papers, specially processed papers, etc.</li> <li>Disposable diapers (Flush the waste down the toilet before disposal.)</li> <li>Video tapes, cassette tapes</li> </ul> <p>* Please take recyclable papers to the Recycling Drive collection point or put in the recyclable bag.</p>		
	Plastic containers and packaging materials	Once a week Day of the week Use the designated bags.	<b>Items with plastic mark</b> <p>Designated bags: プラスチック製容器包装類</p> <p>Plastic items with food that doesn't come off should be disposed of as burnables.</p>	<b>PET bottles</b> <p>Items with plastic mark: Plastic bottles for juice, soda, green tea, mineral water, energy drink, Shouchu spirits, Mirin sweet cooking sake, sake, etc.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove caps from plastic bottles.</li> <li>Rinse lightly.</li> <li>Crush flat the bottles!</li> <li>Remove the labels.</li> </ol> <p>* Put PET bottles in the designated net bag at the collection site on the collection day of plastic materials.</p> <p>* Place the plastic caps and labels in the designated pink colored trash bag.</p>		
Nonburnable garbage	Twice a month Use semi-transparent bags (any color but black).	<b>Hazardous and toxic waste</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disposable lighters, edged tools, dry cells, fluorescent tubes, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Empty gas cylinder. Dry cells should be bagged separately. Wrap the edged tools in paper (such as newspaper) and put a notice saying the item such as "kitchen knife" on it.</p>	<b>Leather and rubber items</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Leather shoes, briefcases, rubber hoses, etc.</li> </ul>	<b>Plastic goods</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food storage vacuum containers, planters and garden troughs, plastic containers, buckets, etc.</li> </ul>	<b>Glass cups and chinaware</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cups, mirrors, plates, rice bowls, planters and garden troughs, heat-resistant glass containers, etc.</li> </ul>	<b>Other</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Umbrellas, cushions, stuffed toys, wood blocks (the three dimensions should be less than 100 cm), carpets (less than 6 tatami-mats in size), etc.</li> </ul> <p>Items that are less than 6 tatami-mats in size and folded into smaller size.</p>
	Recyclables	Once a week Day of the week Use semi-transparent bags (any color but black).	<b>Empty cans</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Soft drink cans, food tins, aerosol cans (Be sure to use up all the contents.), etc.</li> </ul> <p>Rinse lightly before disposal.</p>	<b>Empty bottles</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Drink bottles, food bottles, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Rinse lightly and remove caps from the bottles.</p>	<b>Metals</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pots, kettles, wire hangers, small metallic products, etc.</li> </ul>	<b>Papers</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Newspapers, magazines and recyclable papers (Tie them separately by type with strings.)</li> </ul>

Garbage collection sites should be kept clean by the users. Follow the rules and keep the collection sites clean.

	<b>Collection procedure</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put your used small home appliances in the drop-off boxes which are installed at seven locations in the city.</li> </ul> <p>Items subject to this recycling drive: Items listed below that are smaller than the drop-off box opening (15 x 30 cm)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mobile phones, telephone sets, fax machines, digital cameras, video equipment, audio equipment, hearing aids, computer games, radio and accessories</li> </ul>

# Oversized Garbage Disposal Fee Table

(Sodai gomi or oversized garbage is the comparatively large waste that was unwated in the everyday life.)

## Disposal fee guide

- ① Items with three dimensions (height+length+width) being 100 cm or more
- ② Items within 2.5 meter long
- ③ Items within 100 kg
- ④ Household garbage

## Disposal procedure of home electrical appliances

Unwanted air-conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines and clothe dryers cannot be disposed of as oversized garbage. These items should be disposed of by following one of the steps below.

(In case of replacing the item with a new one) Contact the store you bought the appliance to handle your used one.

(Other than replacing the item with a new one)

- ① Contact a home appliance store to pick up and handle your used item.
  - ② Bring in the item to the place designated by the manufacturer.
  - ③ Contact a city authorized disposal service provider for disposal.
- There is a cost for a pickup and delivery from your home to the manufacturer's designated collection site in the case of ① and ③.

## Disposal procedure of oversized garbage

**1 Application**

(Sundays, national holidays and the New Year holiday are closed.)  
\* Specific information on the item and number of oversized garbage are necessary.  
\* Up to three items can be disposed of at a time.  
\* The weight of an oversized item should be the one that can be carried with two people (less than 100 kg).

**3 Purchase of oversized garbage stickers**

● Oversized garbage sticker handing stores

● An oversized garbage sticker costs 800 yen.

\* There is consumption tax on this fee.

● Please make sure to print your name and the date of collection on the sticker and put it on your garbage.

\* Call Clean Center Shirasagi to schedule a pickup and then purchase oversized garbage stickers.

**4 Collection points**

● Single family houses: in front of the house or garage facing the street

● Housing complex: Easy-to-understand place on the first floor.

\* Garbage in your home will not be collected.  
\* Oversized garbage put out at the collection site will not be collected.  
\* If your curbside pickup location is too narrow for a garbage truck to pass, please negotiate the pickup point when you schedule a pickup.

**2 Collection date**

Once applied, the collection date will be instructed.

**5 Collection time**

By 8 a.m. on the day of collection

Garbage truck

Put out your garbage by 8 a.m. on the day of collection.

## Disposal procedure by bringing in your garbage directly to Clean Center Shirasagi

### Open hours

Weekdays (8:30~12:00, 13:00~16:00)  
Saturdays (8:30~12:00)

- \* Sundays, public holidays and the New Year's holiday are closed.
- \* Each one point costs 400 yen.
- \* There is consumption tax on these fees.
